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INTRODUCTION

The concept of education has undergone a significant change over the past many years and a much wider variety of individual, social and national objectives are expected to be achieved through purposeful and quality education. Such type of education which was once limited to a privileged group of persons, is now demanded by all the sections of the society. The limited means accessible to meet the growing demand of the society for quality education, necessitates an intensive effort to utilize fully the available resources.

The population of the city has considerably increased, while the number of schools imparting quality education has remained static for the last two decades. The English Medium schools, already functioning in Peshawar have limited capacity to accommodate even the requirements of their sponsoring authorities. There has been considerable pressure on these schools and a large number of the students are refused admission every year. It has created an acute problem for the people of Peshawar in particular and the population of the province in general.

Keeping in view the growing need of the people of the area for quality education, the Government of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa established this public school & college at Peshawar in 1979. The Peshawar Public School / College is sponsored by the Education Department, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa situated on Warsak Road in about 82 Kanals (Boys Section) & 24 Kanals (Girls Section) at a distance of 2 Km from Peshawar Cantt. The School / College is equipped with all modern facilities for students with highly qualified and competent staff. It is housed in a grand spacious building and has its play grounds. It aims at providing quality education to the public with special emphasis on Islamiat, Science and on the ideology of PAKISTAN. Admissions are being given on the availability of seats, subject to clearing the admission test.

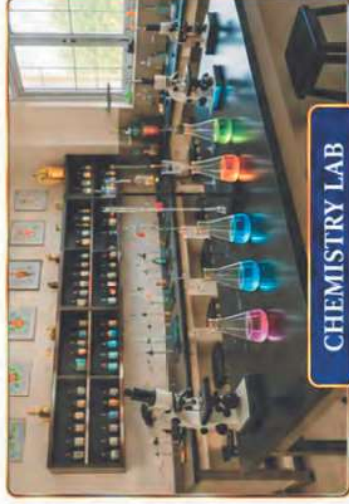


LABORATORIES AND LIBRARY

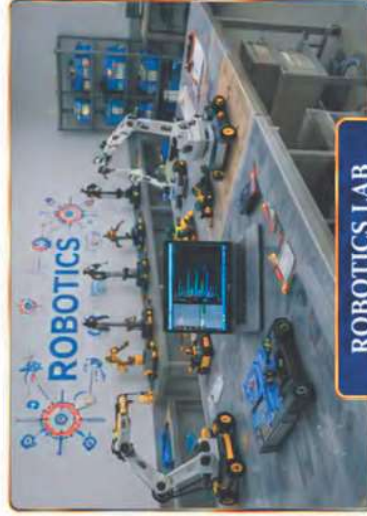

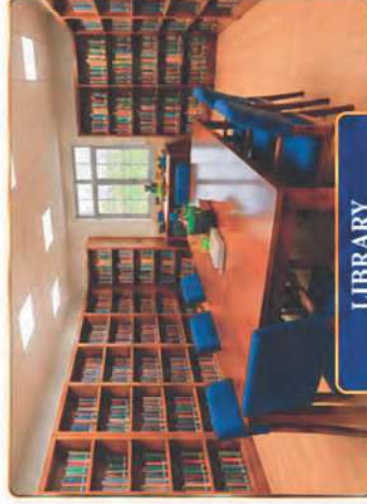

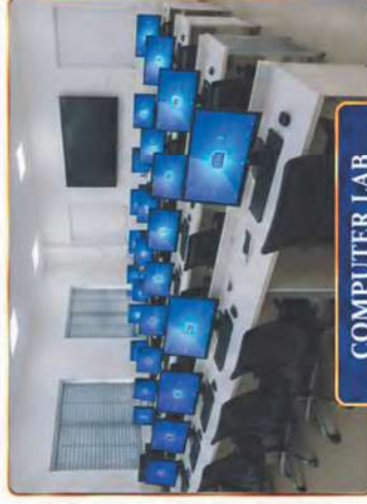

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RULES AND REGULATIONS



Students should be neatly dressed in the prescribed School/College Uniform during School/College hours and examination / practical days.



Students must obtain the School/College Identity-Card within one week of their admission and must keep it with themselves during the College hours.



Students should be regular and punctual in attending classes. Bunking off the classes shall be considered as a serious breach of discipline.



Students must be respectful, obedient and courteous towards the faculty members, office staff, support staff, fellow students and visitors to the Institution. They are to avoid impolite and unseemly behavior and conduct themselves with grace and modesty within and outside the campus.



Students should keep the School/College premises clean and not spread any litter / rubbish around it.



Students should bring their books and note books according to the timetable.



Students should carry their diaries to school daily.



Students should not damage or disfigure school property.



Writing or drawing graffiti on the chairs, desks and walls is strictly prohibited.



Students are not allowed to bring undesired literature to school.



Damage done even by accident should be reported to the class teacher.



Any willful damage to the school property will be made good by the one who caused it.



If a student found breaking or damaging the School/College property, shall be penalized heavily.



Lending or borrowing of money and other articles are not permitted.



Bullying, use of foul language or any other inappropriate behavior will be dealt strictly.



The school reserves the right immediately to suspend, take strict disciplinary action against student whose diligence or progress is constantly unsatisfactory, whose conduct is harmful to other students or whose parents / guardians display unbecoming behavior.



No student will be allowed to go home during school hours. In case of an emergency, permission will be granted by the Principal/Vice Principal.



The following activities are strictly prohibited and may lead to expulsion from School/College:

- ♦ Smoking
 - ♦ Use of intoxicants
 - ♦ Chewing "pan"
 - ♦ Taking "Naswar"
 - ♦ Bringing valuable items (Mobile- phones, Fire-arms, sharp-weapons, Video-games, driving vehicles personally, Bringing immoral and objectionable materials etc)
- If any one of these items was found, will be fined up to Rs 2000+ as the case may be, the items will be returned only to their parents. In some cases, it may lead to expulsion from school/College.



The school is not responsible for lost goods.



Cheating in the examinations, stealing or telling lies shall be viewed as serious breach of good conduct and behavior. The use of unfair means (UFM) in examinations shall be considered as a serious violation of rules and shall lead to cancellation of the papers/examinations.



Violation of rules may result in imposition of fine, suspension, restriction or expulsion from the School/College as the case may be.



Parents must visit the School/College as and when required by the Principal.



Parents / Guardians are not allowed to visit the classes.



Decision of the Principal in all matters relating to admission, discipline, behaviour, suspension, rustication, expulsion, examination, fee, scholarship, working hours, etc. shall be final, binding and cannot be challenged at any level.

ADMISSION POLICY

1 ADMISSION SCHEDULE

- a) Nursery to Secondary:
- PPSC announces admissions every year in February through newspaper advertisements.
 - The entry test is usually held in the 1st or 2nd week of March, and the admission list for selected students is announced in the 3rd or 4th week of March.

b) Typical timeline for Intermediate Admissions:

Note: Pre-admission may start before matric results, but final admission is confirmed after results.

- Programmes offered: Students can take admission in the following Intermediate programs:

 - ICS (Computer Science)

2 ADMISSION PROCEDURE: STEP-BY-STEP

- Prospectus & Registration:**
Parents must visit the school's Admin Office during working hours (8:00 AM – 2:00 PM) to purchase the Prospectus and Admission Form.
Can also be register online from our website www.ppsc.edu.pk
 - Submission:**
 - The filled form must be submitted along with required documents.
 - If applied online then the required documents should be submitted at the time of Entrance Assessment.
 - Entrance Assessment:**
 - Early Years (Nursery/KG): Usually involves an informal interview with the child and parents to assess social and basic verbal skills.
 - Class 1 to 10: A written test is mandatory, covering English, Urdu and Mathematics.

Once selected, parents receive an admission offer and must deposit the fee within the stipulated time to secure the seat.

4 REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- a) Nursery to Class 10: Submit the form & the following attested documents before the last date announced by the school / college.
- Form-8 or Birth Certificate: Original and a photocopy.
 - Passport-sized Photographs: Usually 3 to 4 recent photos.
 - Previous School Records: Report cards and a School Leaving Certificate (SLC) from the last institution attended.
 - Parent/Guardian CNIC: A copy of the father's or guardian's identity card.
- b) Intermediate: Submit the form & the following attested documents before the last date announced by the college.
- Form-8 or CNIC: Original and a photocopy.
 - Passport-sized Photographs: Usually 3 to 4 recent photos.
 - SSC Detail Marks Sheet (DMC) / Transcript
 - Provisional Certificate / School Leaving Certificate
 - Character Certificate

5 KEY POLICIES TO REMEMBER

- Merit-Based:** Admissions are strictly on a merit basis, depending on seat availability.
- Candidate must have passed Matriculation (SSC / Class 10) from a recognized Board of Education.**
- Candidates with at least 70% marks in Matric (with relevant science subjects) are eligible to apply for FSc Pre-Medical, Pre-Engineering or ICS (Computer Science).**
- Students awaiting Matric results can apply provisionally using their Class 9 / SSC Part-1 marks, provided they meet the marks threshold.**
- O-Level students who want to do FSc Pre-Medical are required to bring an equivalence certificate issued by IBCC Islamabad.**
- Scholarships:** PPSC offers Talent Scholarships (for high achievers in BISE exams).
- Tuition Fee Concession:** PPSC offers sibling Fee concession to 2nd onwards wards of the same parent.
- Discipline:** Students must follow college discipline rules.
- After two weeks, subjects cannot be changed.**
- Principal has the authority to accept or reject admission.**

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GENERAL RULES OF ADMISSION

1.  Admission Fee / Hostel Admission Fee/hostel admission form fee, once deposited are non-refundable in any case.
2.  Board Registration, affiliation, etc shall be refunded only if the same has not been already sent to the Board at the time of cancellation.
3.  If a student is migrated from another school, the monthly fee will not be taken from the student which he/she has already paid in another school.
4.  At the time of admission, a student shall deposit the fee beginning from the month following the month in which he/she left the previous institution.
5.  However, in the case of ETEA students, payment of the fee for the entire academic session is mandatory.
6.  The academic session for the school starts in April, whereas the college session starts in Late August beginning of September.
7.  If a student has left the school/college without SLC, without any intimation or application and after some time he comes to get SLC, he/she will pay the fee up to date along with annual dues.
8.  If a student has left the school without SLC and then comes back to continue his/ her education, he must be liable to pay Re-Admission fee, annual dues (if not deposited) and fee up to date.
9.  Bus fee will be charged till date, if a student has not given an application for withdrawing his transport facility of the school and being approved.
10.  1st Year students are bound to clear fee bills from the starting month of the session although they join classes late.

11.  If a student avails the facility of scholarship in 1st year & he/she wants to leave in 1st year or 2nd year. He will have to refund the concessional amount for the months which a student has availed.
12.  Migration is not allowed for ETEA students in any case.
13.  If a student takes late admission in college and he/she has missed the starting two or three months without taking admission in any other college, they will have to pay the fees for the entire session.
14.  Migration application for classes (9th, 10th, 1st year & 2nd year) will not be entertained till announcement of the Board result and outstanding dues will be cleared up to the last date. The student will be bound to attend routine classes.
15.  The approved refund will be paid within 15 days of the receipt of the application.
16.  Refund will be paid through cheque to their parents / guardian.
17.  Fees in case of day scholars must be paid before the 10th of each month in advance. A fine of Rs 200 will be imposed after the due date.
18.  The monthly fee deduction should be applicable as per record of the previous school leaving certificate (SLC)

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POLICIES



STRUCK OFF POLICY



a) Non-payment of Fee:

In case of non-payment of fees for consecutive 2 months the defaulters are struck off the school/college role.



b) In case of Long Absence:

In case of long absence from the school i.e if a student is absence form the school without any information for more than 7 days will be struck off.



c) In case of violation of rules:

A student is liable to be struck off if he violates rules and regulations by:



a. Misbehaving

- In class rooms
- with school / college staff
- School / college canteen
- School / college functions
- In school /college premises

b. Damaging school /college property

c. Fighting and misbehaving with fellow students

d. Indulging in immoral activities.

RE-ADMISSION POLICY



Student once struck off from the school / college can be re-admitted as per the following criteria.

a)

He may be re-admitted at the direction of Principal after the payment of Rs. 5000 through Computerized generated Slip



b)

Application for re admission ma be submitted within seven days after the date of notification of cancellation of admission.



c)

He will have to attend extra coaching classes.



NOTE:

However, the school / college management body has all the legal rights to sustain his cancellation of admission or expel the student in the interest of the school / college.



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ATTENDANCE



Students are required to attend the classes (Lectures and Practicals) regularly throughout the academic year. The irregularity in attendance shall be penalized through imposing fines.



The College administration appreciates 90% or above attendance in the College. 75% attendance is compulsory for Board going students.



If for any reason a student is absent, his leave-application must be sent to the Principal on the same/next day, duly signed by his Parents / Guardian, and must mention the valid reason clearly.



In all cases, leave taken by the student shall be at his own risk. Even a Medical Certificate shall not condone a deficiency in the required attendance percentage.



Leave/ absentee just before or after a local/gazetted holiday are not desirable. In case of absentee adjacent to holidays, the students will be fined Rs.100/- per day.



Short leave is discouraged as it badly affects the momentum of study. A short leave may be granted in rare cases only on parents' request.



Due to shortage of study time, normally leave applications are not accepted after detention examination. In case of absentee, a fine of Rs. 100/- per day, may be imposed along with expulsion from the School/College.



If a student remains absent for a week without any application, or the application is not duly signed by the parents, will be fined Rs.5000/- on account of re-admission fee.



Remaining absent from more than 07 days, the student's name will be struck off from the school / college rolls.



Re admission fee will be charged if an expelled /struck off student is allowed by the Principal to get readmitted.

ADMISSION POLICY FOR ETEA SCHOLARSHIP STUDENTS



1 ELIGIBILITY

- Students shall be eligible for admission under the ETEA Scholarship Scheme only if they are officially notified or nominated by the Directorate of Elementary & Secondary Education (E&SE).



2 ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Students may obtain the prospectus and admission form from the institution and are required to complete and submit all necessary documents along with the ETEA scholarship notification/nomination for admission.
- HSSC Admission (1st Year): Students seeking admission to HSSC 1st Year who have passed the SSC examination are required to submit a fresh admission form. Their registration will be considered as a fresh admission in 1st Year.



3 ACADEMIC SESSION

- The academic session of the institution shall be observed as follows:
- School Section: April to March
 - College Section: July to June



4 FEE POLICY

- ETEA scholarship students admitted in any month of the academic year shall be charged the fee for the full academic session, in accordance with the academic session policy of the institution.



5 REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- The following documents must be submitted at the time of admission:
- Copy of ETEA Scholarship notification/nomination
 - Copy of B-Form or CNIC
 - Four (04) passport-size photographs
 - Previous academic certificates or result card
 - Affidavit as directed by the Directorate of Elementary & Secondary Education (E&SE)
 - School Leaving Certificate (if applicable)



6 ATTENDANCE AND DISCIPLINE

- All scholarship students must maintain regular attendance, satisfactory academic performance, and good conduct. Any violation of institutional rules may result in disciplinary action.



7 COMPLIANCE WITH INSTITUTIONAL RULES

- All ETEA scholarship students shall be bound to follow the rules and regulations of the institution applicable to regular students.



8 SCHOLARSHIP CANCELLATION

- In case of unsatisfactory academic performance or poor results, the scholarship may be cancelled in consultation with the Directorate of Elementary & Secondary Education (E&SE).



9 PAYMENT OF EXPENSES

- All payments related to the ETEA scholarship shall be made to the students/parents strictly in accordance with the criteria and procedure prescribed by the Directorate of Elementary & Secondary Education (E&SE).



10 MIGRATION / WITHDRAWAL

- Migration of ETEA scholarship students to any other institution is strictly not allowed under any circumstances, as per the directions of the Directorate of Elementary & Secondary Education (E&SE).
- If a student chooses to leave the institution voluntarily, his/her scholarship shall be cancelled in consultation with the Directorate of E&SE.



11 HOSTEL ADMISSION (COMPULSORY)

- Admission in the internal hostel is compulsory for all ETEA scholarship students.
- Students admitted to an external hostel or as a day scholar will not be eligible to claim hostel charges, and any hostel dues in such cases will not be reimbursed by the Directorate of E&SE.



12 GRIEVANCE / COMPLAINT PROCEDURE

- ETEA scholarship students are directed to submit any written complaints regarding academics, staff/teacher behavior, poor food quality, or any other relevant issue to the Principal.
- Students are not allowed to directly approach the Directorate of E&SE regarding any issue.
- If a student bypasses the institution and approaches the Directorate directly, it shall be considered a violation of school policy, and may result in cancellation of his/her scholarship by the institution.



13 SUBMISSION OF RESULT / DMC

- Students of Class 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th are required to submit their DMC / result card to the ETEA Incharge of the institution.
- The ETEA Incharge will then submit these results to the Directorate of Elementary & Secondary Education (E&SE) for record and verification.



14 COMPLETION OF STUDIES AND MIGRATION

- ETEA scholarship students are bound to complete their studies up to 12th grade.
- Migration is strictly not allowed under any circumstances.
- If a student voluntarily migrates in any month, his/her scholarship shall be considered cancelled, and he/she will be liable to pay all applicable fees up to the date of study.



15 FEE LIABILITY FOR OBSERVED / UNDISBURSED CHARGES

- If any fee (admission fee, annual dues, or any other fee) is observed or determined by the Directorate / Finance Department but has not been disbursed to the institution, the ETEA scholarship student shall be liable to pay the observed fee.

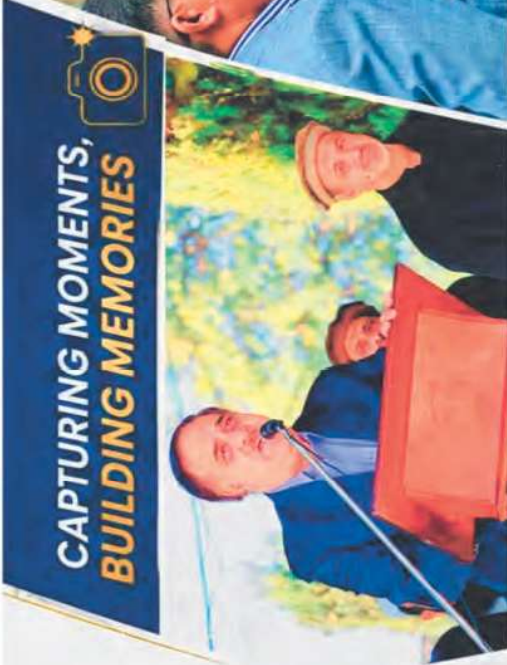

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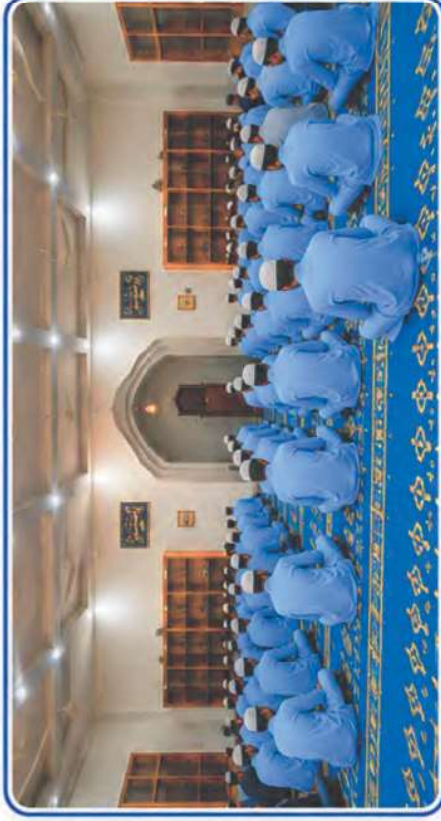


MASJID
